Parents need to sign the waivers for girls under age 18. The itinerary and schedule for the contest and events planned so far is included in this packet. The 2010 Rodeo Royalty Contest will be held at the Rodeo Grounds on Saturday, June 13, 2009 at 10:00 AM with introduction of current royalty, contestants, and judges. Parents and supporters are invited. Cameras are OK. Order of go for the contest will be drawn randomly. This contest has two parts, scored by the judges at 50% each for personality and horsemanship.

A. For personality segment, each girl should have a Western outfit with skirt, cowboy hat, and boots. All shirts or tops must be long sleeved and collared. Each candidate will give a 2-5 minute memorized speech on the topic of "60 Years of the Rodeo de Santa Fe." There will then be a brief modeling session. Each girl will answer two impromptu questions and have a brief personal interview with the judges, who will ask questions from the application.

B. Immediately following this phase of the contest, we will take a 30 minute break and adjourn to the rodeo arena for the horsemanship portion of the contest. There will be three phases for this part.

1. Compulsory pattern – AQHA pattern #2 (provided in application packet) for queen contestants. The Princess and Junior Princess have a simpler pattern, also included in the packet. Dress – long sleeve white shirts, plain, with no decorations of any kind (no buttons, conchos, fringe, etc.), black or blue Wrangler jeans (PRCA sponsor) and cowboy hat. Secure your hat to your head.

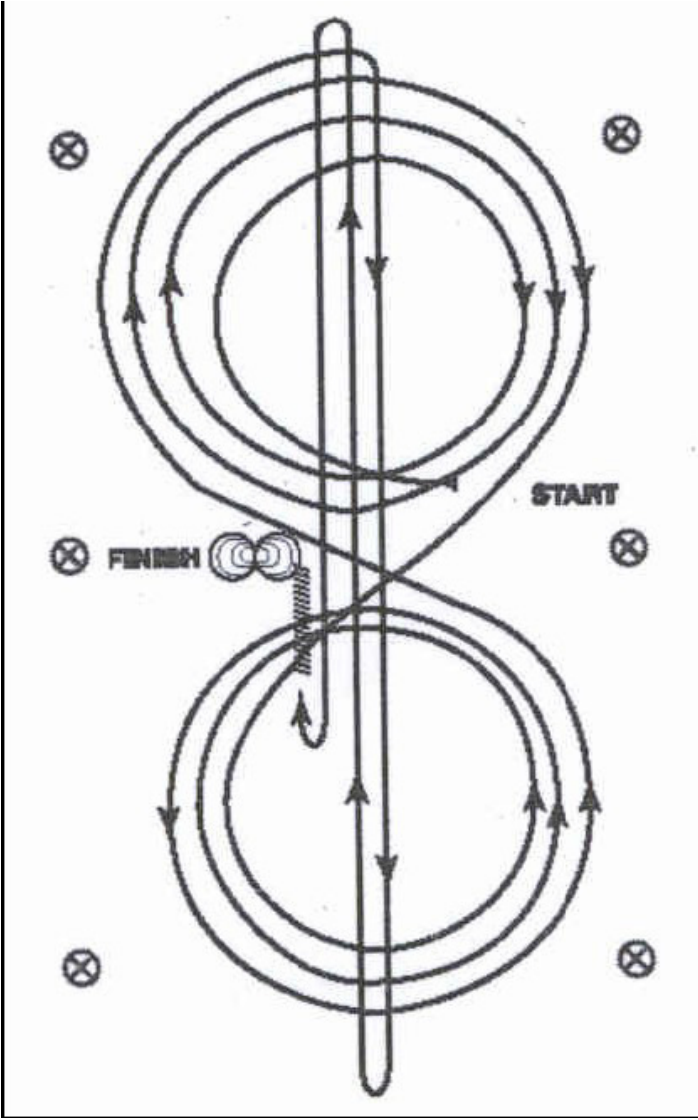
2 . Free style presentation - of your choosing. Music, props, costumes, etc. are OK. Do not exceed 2 minutes. Be creative! Give your music to the Queen Coordinator before we start this phase. Have your cassette tape or CD ready to go. You will have time to change before your turn.

3. Queen's run around the arena, running your horse, and saluting the crowd.

- Maintaining same order of go, girls begin one at a time, one event at a time.
1. Mandatory pattern (AQHA pattern # 2 or Princess pattern); leave arena.
 2. Prepare horse and rider for free style.
 3. Free style horsemanship with costume and music, enter from south end of arena.
 4. Upon completion of free style, do queen's run beginning from southeast gate.



Mandatory Marker Along Fence or Wall

The judge shall indicate with markers on arena fence or wall the length of the pattern. Markers within the area of the pattern are not permitted.

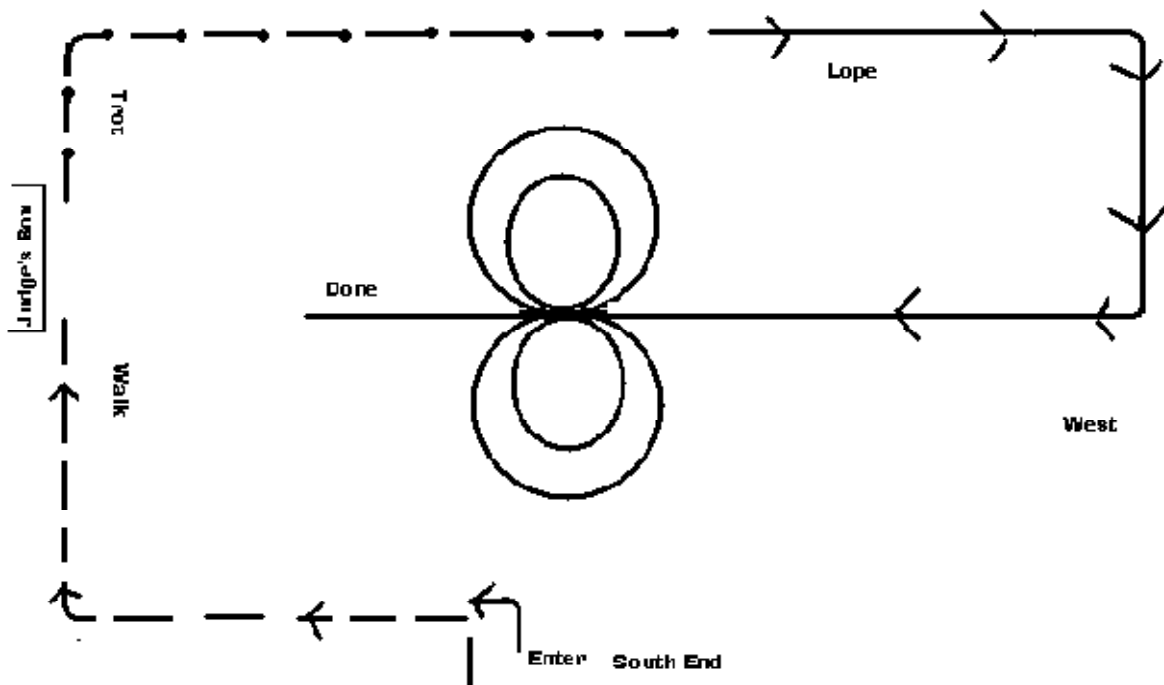
Ride pattern as follows:

Horse must walk or stop prior to starting pattern.

Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
 2. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
 3. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback – no hesitation.
 4. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback - no hesitation.
 5. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (3 meters). Hesitate.
 6. Complete four spins to the right.
 7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.
- Rider may drop bridle to the designated judge.

HORSEMANSHIP PATTERN



1. Walk through gate to left past judge's box
2. Pick up trot at the center of arena/continue to north end
3. Pick up lope to enter of arena/opposite judge's box
4. Do a small figure eight, starting to right
5. Do a large figure eight
6. Continue on to cone and stop and back
7. Dismount and Mount.
